## WHITE SAND CHALET

Atelier Giffon presents a 770-square-meter chalet spread across six floors in Courchevel Village, blending contemporary design with mountain and Mediterranean elements.

The chalet features traditional alpine touches like aged gray wood, wool, and a fireplace, alongside Mediterranean influences such as sand, colorful fabrics, and driftwood. This unique blend creates a surprising and off-season experience for its residents.

The design brief emphasized showcasing the views of the surrounding valleys, incorporating contemporary materials in decorative elements, designing a distinctive spa with an indoor/outdoor pool, and creating a large recreational area complete with a pétanque court.

The chalet's strength and identity are highlighted by direct references to the Côte d'Azur.

This is evident from the landscaping, which includes Mediterranean plant species, to the two main areas inside the chalet.

The spa and its pool are designed to resemble a real beach, featuring 9 tons of sand from the Sainte-Anne quarry. Inspired by Pamplonne Beach, the lower part of the pool area is clad in white-painted red cedar.

The indoor/outdoor pool and its screen aim to provide an immersive experience.

The highlight of the chalet is a journey to the heart of Saint-Tropez, with a reinterpretation of Place des Lices, complete with an authentic pétanque court.
